Once he turned 18, Domingo moved out to the city to work in a factory and started saving his salary with the main goal of buying lands in his town in a future. After nearly 10 years, he started to build his house in his home town, bought some lands and started to plant coffee with the help of his brother. Time later, Domingo returned to San Sebastián and took care of his farm, providing jobs in his community.



The good fame his town San Sebastián gained throughout the years with coffee cultivation, encouraged him and other members of his family to buy more lands and to dedicate full time to coffee.

Domingo started to work with Bon Café since his first crop, 13 years ago, and states that thanks to this relationship he has learned and improved so much about farming practices, the protection of the environment and coffee processes that today have led him to harvest better qualities that leave a better profit for him to provide for his family and to continue expanding his coffee cultivation.
